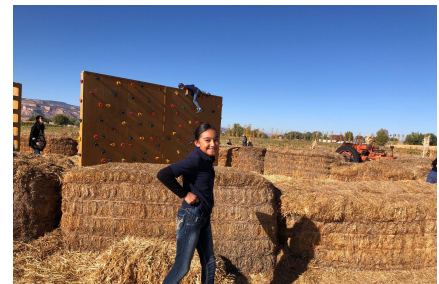
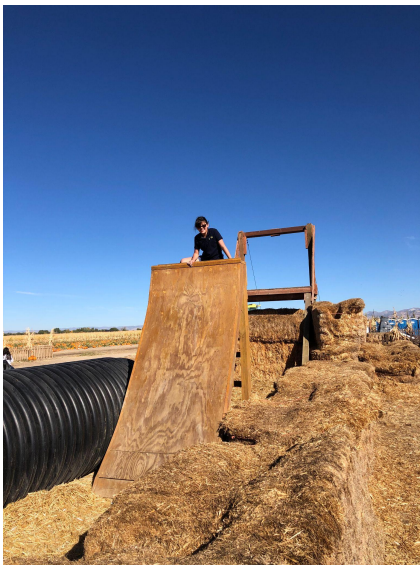
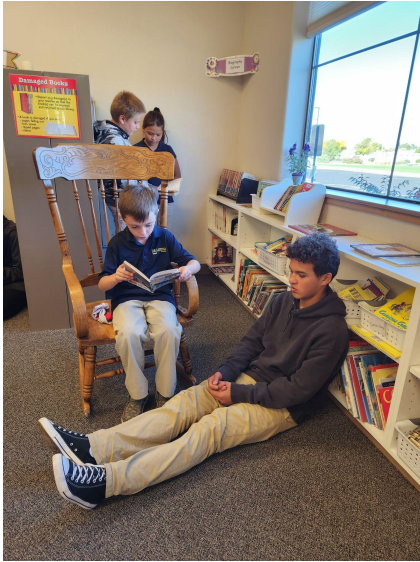
-Favorite Pumpkin Patch Activity-
