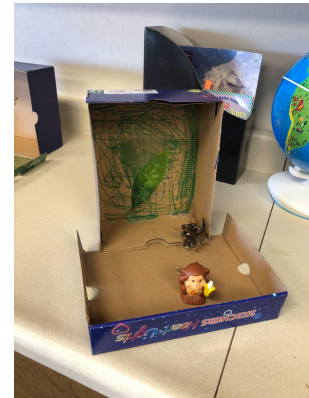
-Favorite Thanksgiving Traditions-
