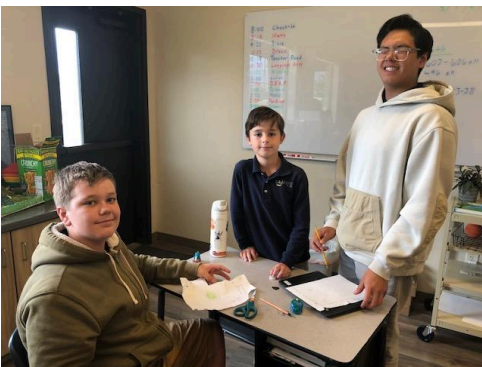
-What is Your Favorite Milkshake or Smoothie Flavor-
